Autogenous vaccines are manufactured under permit from the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA). The efficacy of autogenous vaccines has not been established. Veterinarians are required to request the manufacture and supply of autogenous vaccines from a manufacturer that has a Class 1 GMP licence (autogenous vaccines).

The veterinarian is required to:

- Have an established and valid client / patient / veterinarian relationship.
- Have reasonable grounds for suspecting that the micro-organism(s) to be included in the vaccine is responsible for causing the diseases of concern.
- Keep appropriate clinical records.
- Establish that any available registered vaccines have failed to control the disease in that particular animal species.
