Veterinarians are required to request the manufacture and supply of autogenous vaccines from a manufacturer that has a Class 1 GMP licence (autogenous vaccines).

The veterinarian is required to:

- Have an established and valid client / patient / veterinarian relationship.
- Have reasonable grounds for suspecting that the micro-organism(s) to be included in the vaccine is responsible for causing the diseases of concern.
- Keep appropriate clinical records.
- Establish that any available registered vaccines have failed to control the disease in that particular animal species.
